## Food choices at polo event mounting

It takes more than just horsing around to raise \$200,000 in one afternoon. So, at the 11th annual Denver Polo Classic, the members of Denver Active 20-30 will not only offer the chance to view a championship match, they'll have food from 20 restaurants and libations from around the world.

With 2,000 guests a year, the Polo Classic is the largest professional polo spectator event in the Rocky Mountain region. The 1998 edition takes place July 26 at Columbine Equestrian Center and is chaired by member David Barnes, owner of the Scenographics design firm.

US West is the title sponsor. Other corporate support comes from Guaranty Bank, Stevinson Lexus, Stevinson Jaguar, Taittinger Champagne, Coca-Cola, NAYA and Adolph Coors. Participating restaurants include Brasserie Z, Bistro Adde Brewster, Denver ChopHouse, Mission Trujillo, Ruth's Chris Steak House and The Palm.
